

The 2024 Best of the Best Queensland Water Taste Test

The quest to find Queensland's best tasting tap water

Back by popular demand and open to all Queensland Water Directorate (*qldwater*) members, the **TracWater Best of the Best Queensland Water Taste Test** competition will establish who has the best tasting tap water in Queensland in 2024!

The taste test will take place from **5.45pm on Thursday, 22 August 2024** at **Waters Edge, Portside** as part of the *qldwater* Annual Forum Awards Dinner. The competition aims to celebrate the achievements of the State's urban water service providers and to promote some healthy rivalry among our communities.

Each year the competition gets bigger and better. Since its inception in 2011, the competition now crosses borders with WIOA taking the challenge to NSW with the **Water of Origin Taste Test** with Victoria, South Australia and Tasmania following suit. The first **National Ixom Australia Best of the Best Tasting Tap Water** competition was held in 2015.

Eligibility:

1. The competition is open to all Queensland water service providers who are members of *qldwater*.
2. Entrants must not have had any serious water quality incidents in the last six months. A "serious" water quality incident includes protracted periods of poor water quality, an event leading to immediate potential public health risks or other break-down of risk management protocols.

Requirements:

- Two litres of drinking water for each scheme entered should be shipped to Level 1, 6 Eagleview Place, Eagle Farm QLD 4009 **by COB Wednesday, 21 August** or delivered in person at the *qldwater* Eagle Farm offices **before midday on Thursday, 22 August**. We allow only one entry per service provider.
- Each sample must be submitted in a container which clearly identifies the name of the water provider and the system/scheme it presents. The samples being judged are anonymous.
- Samples will be served at room temperature, to help participants better judge each sample.

Competition Judging:

- Water samples will be judged by all Annual Forum attendees who choose to participate.
- Final scores will be aggregated with the winning score being the highest combined score.
- The winner will be announced at the event and publicly through media releases after the event. Only the winning sample and runner up will be announced. Samples will not be ranked and scores will not be released.
- The decision of the judges is final.

Prize:

- Trophy for winner and runner up.
- Winner has the opportunity to compete against NSW in the Water of Origin taste test.
- Promotion through *qldwater* communications, press releases etc.
- The unique honour of being the provider of the best tasting tap water in Queensland!
